MOTION #1

Motion to contribute up to \$70,000 to Independent Expenditures to support primary election candidates for City of Los Angeles races that EAA has endorsed.

Moved by Political Action Committee, no second required.

Governor Cruz confirmed we have about \$82,000 in our accounts. This is our last time to discuss before the June 2nd Primary Election. Supporting this motion would give us the flexibility to decide where to contribute to make the biggest impact. Would give us broad latitude to discuss contributions with various committees.

Some examples are ACCE's committee focusing on a door knocking effort identifying voters for Marissa Roy and Estuardo Mazariegos.

For Marissa Roy, we would be the only IE for that social media effort through Mosaic consulting. The BOG has already approved \$20,000, which is separate from the proposed amount under Motion #1.
